Safeguarding children is an important aspect of our work and we expect all staff and volunteers to share this responsibility.

The Children's University (CU)

(CU Norfolk) is an organisation that promotes out of school learning for all primary-aged pupils, from Reception.

We sell CU Passports for £5 each from the school office. Children use these to record the hours of activity they do after school or at weekends by collecting accredited ink stamps from activity providers.

Our after school clubs also give out stamps for each hour of activity, except for Film Club and lunchtime activities. Children can also receive validation for home learning activities as well as from many other organisations outside the school, such as Guides, NW Sports Centre, museums and libraries.

Children need over 30 hours of activity stamps to gain certificates each year and might even attend a graduation ceremony and wear a gown!

Infant parents for Year R are welcome to come in with their children in the morning but please be aware this makes the corridors and classrooms very congested for a short period. Buggies/pushchairs should be left outdoors please.

Earrings and PE Lessons/Long Hair

Please remove the earrings from your child's ears before school, if they have a PE lesson that day. If you would prefer, you could provide a roll of medical tape for them to keep in school to cover their earrings instead, so we avoid any nasty injuries occurring during the physical activity. Longer hair should be tied back in school all day as well. It's smarter, tidier and helps to prevent headlice spreading.

Morning and afternoon routines

We believe it is really important for children to have a positive start and finish to the school day.
