We have a School Improvement and Development Plan each year to follow, which sets out the priorities for the development of the schools.

This next school year will be another exciting and challenging one. The Governors and Senior Leadership Team will be leading the schools into academy conversion and joining the Yare Education Trust. The Senior Leadership Team has been re-structured, whilst Mrs Fletcher joins the Trust as Director of Schools for 3 days each week.

Staff are focussed on implementing improvements to the curriculum and how children are assessed, so that every child can be supported to be the best they can be. Major re-building works next year will have a positive impact (eventually) on the space the infant school children will have to work in. The main target areas our staff will be working on are set out below, for your information:

Target 1 Focus: To ensure that the expectations for teaching and learning, school systems and behaviour management are consistently maintained

Target 2 Focus: To ensure that teachers promote even more opportunities for pupils to extend their learning and develop creativity and innovation

Target 3 Focus: To ensure assessments guide high quality teaching which meets children’s needs including extra intervention and challenge

Target 4 Focus: To ensure that children are fully active citizens within the school community
