Challenge:

Make a map to show your route from home to school

The National Curriculum says:

- I should be able to use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of my school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment (Year 1 and 2)
 - I should devise a simple map; and use and construct basic symbols in a key (Year 1 and 2)
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- I need to learn my address.
 - I need to learn that I live in the country of England which is part of the United Kingdom.
 - I need to learn that my school is in the town of North Walsham. The nearest city is Norwich.
 - I should be able to find North Walsham on a map of the United Kingdom.

I need to recognise and name these physical features:

beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley, vegetation

A **physical** feature is one that occurs naturally. A **human** feature is one created by humans.

Maps:

- Show a "birds eye" view of a place - from above
- Usually show only permanent features
- Often use symbols to represent the features
- Should have a key to explain what the symbols mean
- Sometimes show North, South, East and West

I need to recognise and name these human features:

city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour, shop
